If you are in the US on an F1 or F2 student visa you are neither a citizen nor an eligible non-citizen. If you are neither a citizen nor an eligible non-citizen you are ineligible for federal student aid. However, you may still file an annual FAFSA as in some cases you may be eligible for college aid.
