

SELECTIVE SERVICE CONFIRMATION

According to information we received on your Free Application for Federal Student aid (FAFSA) from the Selective Service Agency, your registration with Selective Service could not be confirmed. Not everyone is required to fulfill this requirement. Male US citizens and certain residents are required to register with Selective Service between the ages 18-26. Please review the information below for instructions regarding how to resolve this matter. Female student.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You are not required to register with Selective Service. If you did not indicate your gender on the Free Application for Federal Financial Aid (FAFSA), go to http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/ and respond to the gender question. Remember to sign your corrected FAFSA with your pin number. Be sure to have your parent sign each correction as well if you are a dependent student.
Male student between the ages 18 - 26.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If student is not registered student may register at http://www.sss.gov and submit confirmation to our office. If have registered you may submit a copy of the registration card or obtain a copy of the registration online at http://www.sss.gov
Male student over the age of 26 and did not register with Selective Service between the ages of 18 – 26.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Complete and submit the Selective Service Information Status Request form online at: https://www.sss.gov/RegVer/wfVerification.aspx. Submit a copy of the Selective Service Status Information Letter to the Office of Student Financial Aid. If the Selective Service Status Information letter does not waive or release your obligation to register please attach a statement explaining your reason or rationale for not registering with Selective Service.
Male student is a noncitizen who first entered the U.S. after he turned 26.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Submit documentation indicating timeframe of when student entered the U.S. under the status of noncitizen.
Male student is a noncitizen who entered the U.S. as a lawful <i>nonimmigrant's</i> on a valid visa and remained in the U.S. on the terms of that visa until after he turned 26.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Submit documentation indicating the timeframe of when you entered the U.S. under the status of lawful nonimmigrant.
Male student was unable to register due to being hospitalized, incarcerated, or institutionalized.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Submit documentation indicating the timeframe of the student's hospitalization, incarcerations, or institutionalization.
Male student is enrolled in any officer procurement program at The Citadel, North Georgia College and State University, Norwich University, Virginia Military Institute, Texas A&M University, or Virginia Polytechnic and State University.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Submit documentation indicating the timeframe of the student's enrollment.

OSFA cannot proceed with your application until your selective service confirmation is complete. Many financial aid programs have specific deadlines, and delays in processing may result in a reduction or loss of potential financial aid awards. Be sure to include your name and student ID number on any documents you submit.
