Never was a cadet or midshipman at a service academy; was/am in the National Guard or Reserves and was never activated for duty but served for training purposes; 3. Served in the U.S. Armed Forces and was discharged dishonorably; 4. Was an ROTC student; or 5. Is currently engaged in the U.S. Armed Forces, National Guard/Reserves in active duty or 6. Is a cadet/midshipman and will not be discharged by the end of the fiscal year. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student is required to change his Veteran Status to "No" to his Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). <p>NOTE: If this is the only reason the student is considered an Independent student on the FAFSA application the student will be required to add parental data and signature to the FAFSA as well.</p>

OSFA cannot proceed with your application until your veteran's status is confirmed. Many financial aid programs have specific deadlines. Delays in processing your application may result in a reduction or loss of financial aid awards. Be sure to include your name and student ID number on any documents you submit.
